

## SCOPE OF SERVICES & SPECIFICATIONS

The Prescott Unified School District is seeking a Wide Area Network. The District expects a high bandwidth; high reliability solution that is either Wireless, land based Copper/Optical Ethernet, or equivalent transport. The solution proposed must be compliant with the current SLD E-Rate Eligible Services List for Priority 1 funding, including any initial non-recurring costs.

The prospective vendor's proposal **must** include a contracted price to increase each of the locations above in 10 Mbps increments to a maximum of 100 Mbps per site. The hub should be quoted in increments of 50 Mbps to a maximum of 500 Mbps.

The existing bandwidth supports the data network only. Voice traffic will continue to be provided by the existing vendor and is not a part of the Scope of Services.

**TERM OF CONTRACT**

It is the intent of the Prescott Unified School District to award a 5 year contract. The contract term shall begin on the Network Acceptance Date through the time period specified in the Contract Acceptance and Award section of this document. Amendments may be issued during the term of the contract to increase bandwidth at individual locations.
