RE: Medical Prescriptions for Students with Allergies

USDA requires each school to have a Medical Prescription for all students who have food allergies. This must be signed by a recognized medical authority and must list all allergies that the student has. When we get this prescription we then keep a copy of the prescription at the school and one at the food service office. When we receive it at the food service office we will enter an alert on the computer system stating what the allergies are. We will then be able to help monitor the needs of the students.

The cashier is notified of the alert each time the customer comes thru the serving line and she has to answer that alert saying that she has seen it. This protects our students from eating foods that will cause them problems.

Please send to us as soon as possible a copy of the prescription. To either the Food Service Manager at the school that your child is going to or to 926 ½ Hinman St., Prescott AZ 86305
